ADMISSION RIGHTS

*Binding arbitration is an alternative to judges or ourts settling disputes between onsumers and businesses. It means to work out a deal through an independent, third-party body. The arbitrator's decision is final and cannot be disputed or appealed. This removes the right to sue in ourt.

Effective 09/16/2019 if you or your representative are alked to sign an agreement for binding arbitration the facility must:

- 1. Not require the signature a a ondition of admission, or a a requirement to ontinue to receive care a the facility and clearly tell you or your representaive of this requirement.
 - 2. Explain the agreement to you and your representative in a way that you understand;
- 3. Have you and your representave acknowledge that you understand the agreement;
 - 4. Have the agreement give you or your representative this right to cancel the agreement within 30 days of signing it.
- You have the right to review the facility's admission agreement/ontract and its rules and policies prior to admission.
- You cannot be discriminted against in the admission process baed upon your source of payment (private, LTC insurance, Medicare, Medicaid, etc.)
- You have the right to choose where you want to live either in a long-term care setting or in your home and ommunity. The long-term care facility location you choose may not have an immediate opening so you may have to go where there is an opening and move when you can to your choice of location. For information on home and ommunity service support calls 1-855-462-5465 (option 1).
- You can request and receive, in **writing**, the reaon for the denial of your admission. The facility shall not in the written denial if the denial is baed on the special characteristics or service limitations of the facility.
- The facility can't require your family or friends to ommit to pay your facility bill from their personal funds.
- You cannot be required to give advance payment, grauity, or gift to the facility to asure admission or to be placed on the waiting list.
- You cannot be aked to waive or give up any of your rights a a ondition of admission or to ontinue to live a the facility.
- You can't be aked or required to waive facility liability for losses of your personal property.
- You must be given notice of special features or service limitaions of the facility prior to admission.
